No. BBT.1063/37005-G, dated 27th July 1965, Govt. is pleased to direct that one day special casual leave granted to Govt. servants who donate blood voluntarily should be given to the donor either on the same day ~~xxxx~~ or on the very next day of the donation of blood but not on any other subsequent days as the intention of Govt. is to give some rest to the persons after blood donation as well as to encourage them to give blood voluntarily.
